RIOJA BLANCO 'Monopole' 2014 [O]<br>C.V.N.E., Haro, Rioja Alta, Spain<br><i>This could only be white Rioja, with its intense, crisp, citrusy fruit, which has been barrel-fermented, giving a pervasive oakiness and a lovely long, creamy finish. Superb!</i>   | 27.50  |
| 33. PICPOUL DE PINET 2015<br>Domaine St. Peyre, Languedoc, France<br><i>Dry, crisp and fragrant, with a distinctive nutty nuance. Perfect with seafood, white fish, poultry or as an aperitif. The grape is Picpoul and the village is Pinet, about 10km north of Aude, near Marseille. CÔTES DE NUITS VILLAGES 2014<br>Domaine Xavier Durand, Burgundy, France [100% Pinot Noir]<br><i>The energetic and highly talented young Xavier Durand has propelled this domaine into the region's premier league. These are wines of great precision and freshness, with a wonderful purity. Xavier's reds from the Côte de Nuits surpass many a Nuits St. Georges and are phenomenal value.</i>   | 37.95  |
| 46. GEVREY CHAMBERTIN, 2011<br>Domaine Maume, Côte de Nuits, Burgundy, France<br><i>Domaine Maume's wines are deep, profound Pinot Noir experiences. They are bottled from barrel by gravity without any pumping, fining or filtration. The average age of the vines is 50 years, so there is a delicious intensity on the palate, with lots of red fruit and cherries and an undercurrent of minerality providing structure .</i>  | 65.00  |
| 47. CHÂTEAU DES JOUALLES 2010<br>Bordeaux Supérieur, France<br><i>From the same team that made the excellent Château Lassegue St Emilion. This is deeply coloured, ripe, fruit-driven Claret with excellent structure. [60% Merlot; 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc]</i>   | 23.50  |
| 48. RIOJA CRIANZA 'Hacienda Lopez de Haro' 2013<br>Bodega Classica, Rioja, Spain<br><i>A smooth and velvety Crianza that feels quite classical in style but puts on a very modern display of vibrant ripe fruit. A blend of old-vines Tempranillo, Garnacha and Graciano that sees 18 months in French and American oak, it shows clean, spicy dark fruit with hints of leather, coffee and dried herbs. The palate is polished and succulent with sweet, rounded tannins and well-integrated toasty vanilla oak. (Robert Parker - 91 points)</i> | 24.95  |
| 49. PINOT NOIR 2014<br>St Clair, Marlborough, New Zealand<br><i>A well structured, medium bodied Pinot Noir from the award winning St Clair estate showing ripe red cherry, black currant and raspberry with an amazing long finish.</i>  | 31.00  |

Domaine de Coussergues, Pays d'Oc, France  
*This is not a jammy Pinot as it has an appealing freshness and vivacity that raises it to a serious class. It is quite remarkable value. The palate is bursting with strawberry and blackberry fruit with a hint of woodiness against a rich, earthy backdrop. Good acidity and length.*
52. SALICE SALENTINO 'Il Pumo' 2011 22.00  
Cantine San Marzano, Puglia, Italy  
*South of Brindisi lies the Salento Peninsula that extends towards Albania and Greece and is Italy's easternmost point. The finest Puglian wines are produced in this area of Puglia where the soil is red on a calcareous base. This is a very attractive round wine with hints of wild cherries, plums, ripe fruits and spice. Soft tannins with a touch of oak on the finish.*
53. PINOTAGE 2014 19.95  
 Slowine, Overberg, Western Cape, South Africa  
*A deliciously juicy Pinotage full of summer plums and spice with a big, luscious mouthfeel and a peppery finish. 'Slowine' is a collective project by producers from the area around the Groenland Mountain who believe in the 'Slow living' ethos. Some of the proceeds from the sale of these wines is dedicated to the conservation of the Padloper tortoise who features on the wine label.*
54. MERLOT-GRENACHE 'Les Terrasses' 2014/15 16.95  
 Les Vignerons Ardéchois, Ardeche, France  
*A soft, rounded and fruity red from long-established vineyards in the foothills of the Cevennes mountains, between the Ardeche and La Baume rivers. Deep-coloured with a bouquet of red cherries, this is well -balanced and very approachable with an emphasis on ripeness and 'crunchy' fruit.*
56. MONASTRELL 'La Tremenda' 2014 23.00  
Enrique Mendoza, Alicante, Spain  
*Intense, succulent bramble fruit with complex spicy nuances. Ripe, supple, complex and utterly beguiling.*
57. MERLOT 2014 19.25  
 Cornellana Estate, Rapel Valley, Chile  
*Rich, deep and plummy with hints of chocolate on the nose. It is easy to see why Chile has become a spiritual home for Merlot.*

58. CÔTES DU RHÔNE VILLAGES 'Visan' 2012/13 [ORGANIC & BIODYNAMIC] 27.95  
Domaine Roche-Audran, Buisson, Rhône, France  
*A deep-coloured meaty red with excellent purity of fruit and a fleshiness combined with suppleness that is so rarely achieved. Wonderful complexity and a long finish. This is very talented wine-making indeed.*
59. MASSAYA 'Le Colombier' 2013 30.95  
Tanail Estate, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon  
*One of our most exciting discoveries, this is the result of a collaboration between one of the best Chateauneuf du Pape producers (Daniel Brunier of Vieux Telegraphe), Dominique Hebrard of Chateau Trianon (St Emilion) and the Lebanese proprietors of this estate, Sami and Ramzi Ghosn. A smooth, supple and spicy blend of Cinsault, Grenache, Tempranillo and Syrah, it's amazing and quite unique.*
60. MALBEC 'ES Vino' 2015 24.95  
 Finca Sopenia, Tunpungato, Mendoza, Argentina  
*Intense aromas of cherries, blackberries, blueberries and fresh plums with spicy and floral notes. A complex, concentrated palate of ripe fruit with smooth tannins and a hint of chocolate on the finish. This modern winery is located in the high altitude Tupungato Valley region of Mendoza where the grapes benefit from a long, cool growing season and strong UV sunlight which helps maximise the aromas and complexity of the grapes. Superstar Bordeaux wine consultant Michel Rolland has added his expertise to this project.*
61. SHIRAZ 'Whistling Duck' 2015 19.95  
 Calabria Family Wines, Griffith, New South Wales, Australia  
*A sumptuous Aussie classic with rich flavours of ripe plums, dark cherries and fresh blackberries, and a dash of peppery spice on the finish.*
62. PIC ST LOUP 'Dame Jeanne' 2014 29.95  
Bergerie du Capucin, Languedoc, France  
*Relatively unknown here, but much appreciated in the rest of Europe, Pic St Loup is the Languedoc's hidden gem. A blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre, aged in oak for six months, this is lush and jam-packed with silky, spicy, gamey, blackberry and cherry fruit with a hint of liquorice and chocolate on the finish.*
63. CABERNET SAUVIGNON 'BMW' 2009 39.95  
Botham Merrill Willis, Coonawarra, Australia  
*Cricket legends and fellow wine buffs, Sir Ian Botham and Bob Willis joined forces with one of Australia's top wine makers, Geoff Merrill, to launch their own range of fine wines. The colour of this wine is very deep red with youthful purple hues. On the nose, intense varietal characters of menthol, black olive, mint and capsicum with subtle complex oak in the background. The palate is wonderfully supple and fleshy with fine, firm tannins providing excellent structure. Intense flavour, good length and well-balanced acidity complete this outstanding wine.*

| 65. BAROLO RISERVA 2009<br>Costa di Bussia, Piedmont, Italy<br><i>Award-winning Barolo from a great producer. Matured in oak casks for three years to develop slightly gamey, spicy tones for which Barolo Riservas are famed. This great wine has firm tannins combined with ripe fruit flavours and a long finish.</i>  | 57.00  |
| 66. CHÂTEAU BÉARD LA CHAPELLE 2010<br>St Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France [90% Merlot; 7% Cabernet Franc; 3% Cabernet Sauvignon]<br><i>With a mix of blackcurrant and vanilla aromas lifted by a fresh note of aniseed, this opulent wine is well-balanced with layers of rich black fruit flavours and a long mineral finish that is silky smooth. Situated in the village of St Laurent-des-Combes, the Chateau has been in the same family for nine generations. Since 2006, winemaker Franck, together with his sister Laurence, has worked hard to make the Chateau a success and today Beard La Chapelle is definitely a rising Grand Cru star within the St Emilion Appellation - one to watch in the coming years!</i> | 45.00  |
| 67. CARMENÈRE RESERVA 'In Situ' 2014<br>Viña San Esteban, Aconcagua Valley, Chile<br><i>Ripe, rounded and packed with concentrated plum fruit with hints of liquorice, dark chocolate and spice. Soft, elegant tannins and a long finish. Delicious.</i>  | 25.50  |
| 68. CHÂTEAU SOCIANDO-MALLET 2010<br>Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France<br><i>The classic 2010 displays everything one expects from this over-achieving Haut-Médoc. A dense purple colour is followed by aromas of blueberries, black currants, graphite and crushed rocks, a layered, full-bodied mouthfeel, stunning concentration and sweet, polished and refined tannins.</i>  | 75.00  |

CHÂTEAUNEUF DU PAPE 2010<br>Domaine La Roquette, Rhône, France<br><i>Surpassing its more famous sister, Vieux Télégraphe, in recent press tastings (both estates are run by the Brunier brothers,) this is very rich, with an intense blackberry and liquorice fruitiness. Unfiltered, to retain the true character of the region, this is a 'benchmark' wine of genuine world class.</i>   | 56.95  |
